An inter-professional team providing specialised care in oncology



AT HOME

Home-based treatment and care organised in close collaboration with Geneva's social health network

Are you being treated for cancer?

Are you in need of comprehensive care adapted to your needs?

IMAD's inter-professional oncology team (EISO) can provide you with the support you need in the comfort of your home.

IMAD's EISO team provides a comprehensive cancer care programme at home, which complements the care provided by IMAD and oncologists. The EISO team delivers healthcare and other services that best meet your needs. These include nursing care, help with daily activities, home adjustments, nutritional follow-up and social support. House visits are coordinated between the EISO team, your GP (general practitioner) and supporting medical team, and members of Geneva's local care and support network.



A team of experts

The team consists of experienced nurses, community healthcare assistants and caregivers who work interprofessionally with ergotherapists, dieticians and experienced oncology social workers. This team can act quickly to deliver coordinated support and specialized care adapted to your circumstances and needs, 7 days a week and, if needed, several times a day.





A mobilised network

EISO guarantees the continuity of optimal oncological care with in-patient and outpatient care, thanks to its close cooperation with other IMAD teams, the Oncology Department at your hospital or clinic, your GP, your family and members of the Geneva social health network. Geneva social health network notably includes the Ligue genevoise contre le cancer, OTIUM, Resiliam, As'trame, Proximos, your local pharmacy, etc.

We respect your privacy

IMAD's healthcare workers will always maintain confidentiality and ensure your privacy.

Practical information

Any adult with cancer, living in the canton of Geneva and being treated for cancer is eligible for IMAD's cancer care programme at home.

- To request treatment, your GP or oncologist needs to send IMAD a request for Homecare treatment, based on jointly defined criteria.
- 2. IMAD will contact you to set up a first appointment at home. During this meeting, a referral nurse will assess your situation and make suggestions for your care. He or she will then become your main contact throughout your care pathway as well as for your family, your oncologist and your GP.
